Be With Jesus

- When am I with Jesus?
- Do I regularly worship God?

Become Like Jesus

- Am I becoming more like Jesus?
- Am I learning the practices of Jesus alongside other disciples?
- Am I in a small group?

Do What Jesus Did

- Where am I doing what Jesus did?
- Where do I find accountability to live like Jesus?

After each person shares, someone offers to pray for the person and how they want to grow as a follower of Jesus.

When all have had the opportunity to share and have been prayed for, it's time to wrap up.
